List the high schools and school system in which you were employed, the position(s) held and the dates of service in each school. Only high school service can be considered. A principal, assistant principal or coach becomes eligible when he/she has met the requirements stated in Rule 3.12.3 (*LHSAA Official Handbook*) and is no longer active in these positions. <u>One does not have to be officially retired with the retirement board</u>. To receive this lifetime card, he/she must make application through the LHSAA with the proper documentation. The privilege shall be retroactive to the year 1930.

Retired principals or coaches who qualify and who retired from a private or parochial member school may also receive such card upon verification of years served.
