**ALLSTATE SUGAR BOWL LHSAA STATE GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Division II Boys Final Story
Tuesday, May 4, 2021, at The Wetlands (6,348 yards, par 72), Lafayette, La.**

LAFAYETTE – Ross Anderson of St. Louis Catholic claimed the individual title and his Saints team rallied from behind in Tuesday’s final round to take the team title in the Division II boys’ competition of the Allstate Sugar Bowl LHSAA State Golf Championships.

The Saints, who trailed tournament host Teurlings Catholic by six shots entering the final round, put together a 306 score in Tuesday’s final round over the 6,348-yard par-72 The Wetlands layout. That gave St. Louis, the 2019 runner-up, a two-day 616 total and a two-stroke win over Teurlings in the team chase.

Anderson, who had Monday’s low round with a two-under 70, added a 75 on Tuesday, and his 145 total was good enough for a three-stroke victory over Collin Duplechain of Teurlings Catholic (73-75—148). St. Louis teammate George Trappey finished third individually at 71-78—149.

St. Thomas More, the defending Division II champion from 2019, finished third with a 628 score and had two top-five finishers. Zach Hardy and James Stonecipher both carded 150 totals to finish tied for fourth. Stonecipher’s even-par 72 shared Tuesday’s low-round honors with Jonathan Perry of St. Louis, who improved 11 strokes from his opening 83.

Dax Reaux of Teurlings Catholic, Alexander Walker of Caddo Magnet and Preston Giroir of Holy Cross tied for sixth at 154 while Jonathan Perry of St. Louis and Walt Sartor of Neville rounded out the individual top 10 in tying for ninth at 155.
