RULE 10 PENALTY ENFORCEMENT

(updated August 7, 2023)

PURPOSES OF THE NEW 2023 PENALTY ENFORCEMENT RULES

- Eliminate overly punitive penalties for offense and overly lenient penalties for defense when the normal enforcement spot for common fouls involving contact with teammates or opponents is behind the neutral zone (e.g. holding, illegal use of hands, personal fouls).
- Keep extra-punitive penalties for less common offensive fouls for rule violations against which opponents would not expect to defend (e.g. illegal kicking, batting, intentional grounding, illegal forward pass, participating without a helmet, entering the field and participating during the down).
- Clarify that penalties for offensive fouls in the end zone include the option of a safety.

Not Intended To Change Long Understood Penalty Enforcement In Other Situations Not Intended To Change Special Enforcements Listed In Rule 10, Section 5

THE NEW PENALTY RULE CREATES A LIMITATION RULE & A FEW EXCEPTIONS

LIMITATION RULE

Penalties For the <u>Most Common Fouls</u> by <u>Either Team</u> During <u>Scrimmage Downs</u> That Occur <u>Before a Change Of Possession</u> Are <u>Enforced From No Further Back Than the Previous Spot</u> and <u>No Longer From Behind The Neutral Zone.</u>

- So, there is no more 1st and 30 for Team A after a holding foul 10 yards deep in the offensive backfield. Enforcement is now from the previous spot, resulting in only a 10-yard net loss for Team A.
- Also, there is no more 1st and 15 for Team A when the defense holds a receiver downfield and takes away a receiving target eventually causing a sack for a 15yard loss. Enforcement is now from the previous spot, resulting in 10-yard net gain for Team A.

EXCEPTIONS

- 1. Penalties For the Following <u>Limited Set of Offensive Fouls</u> When <u>Committed</u>
 Behind The Neutral Zone Are Enforced From The Spot Of The Foul:
 - Illegal kicking or batting
 - Illegal participation (9-6-4-a & 9-6-4-g)
 - Illegal forward passes (7-5-2-c) and Intentional grounding (7-2-5-d)
 - So, Team A doesn't get the benefit of the new previous spot enforcement on these special fouls. Instead, they are always enforced from the spot of the foul if committed behind the neutral zone, even if the end of the run is behind the spot of the foul.
 - 2. Offensive Fouls In The Offense's End Zone Always Result In A Safety
 - So, Team A doesn't get the benefit of the new previous spot enforcement if they commit fouls in their own end zone while on offense. As before, enforcement results in a safety.

- 1. DURING A SCRIMMAGE DOWN; **AND**
- 2. BEFORE A CHANGE OF POSSESSION **Both are needed.**
- 1. RELATED RUN ENDS BEHIND THE NEUTRAL ZONE; OR
- 2. OFFENSE FOULS BEHIND THE NEUTRAL ZONE *Only one is needed.*

IF YOU DON'T HAVE THE "WHEN" AND THE "WHERE," ENFORCE UNDER ALL-BUT-ONE
IF YOU HAVE THE "WHEN" AND "WHERE," GO LEFT TO RIGHT TO FIND THE ENFORCEMENT
(Why Left to Right? Options go from furthest back: end zone, offensive backfield, previous spot)

WHAT ABOUT FOULS AFTER A CHANGE OF POSSESSION OR DURING FREE KICKS

Enforce the same as in previous years under all-but-one principle. The End of the related run is the basic spot. Offensive fouls behind this spot are enforced from the spot of the foul. All other fouls are enforced from the end of the run.

CAN OFFICIALS STILL CONSIDER THE ALL-BUT-ONE / THREE-AND-ONE PRINCIPLE

YES, FOR FOULS THAT OCCUR DURING FREE KICKS AND FOR FOULS THAT OCCUR AFTER A CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION.

ALSO

YES, BUT ADD IN THE LIMITATION RULE WHEN NECESSARY. Although the rule book no longer references this principle, the new rule intended only the new enforcements discussed above. Applying the principle may assist in implementing the new rule.

Under the all-but-one / 3-and-1 principle, all fouls are penalized from the basic spot **EXCEPT** a foul by the offense behind the basic spot. That foul is penalized from the spot of the foul. Officials may continue to apply the traditional all-but-one principle. **HOWEVER**, that principle is now **limited by the previous spot** with a few exceptions.

Remember, the basic spot for unsportsmanlike fouls, dead-ball fouls, and non-player fouls is still the **succeeding spot**.

IS THERE ANYTHING IN THE NEW RULE THAT OFFICIALS SHOULD IGNORE

YES. Ignore 10-4-5-e, f, & g.

Applying these sections as written could result in unintended and strange enforcements. For these situations, the basic spot is the end of the related run.

Penalize all fouls from the basic spot except an offensive foul behind that spot (spot of foul) under basic 3-and-1 enforcement.

IS THERE ANYTHING OFFICIALS NEED TO ADD TO THE NEW RULE

YES.

10-4-5-d & 10-4-6: APPLY THREE-AND-ONE PRINCIPLE.

 If the offense fouls behind the 20-yard line (succeeding spot), penalize from the spot of the foul.

10-4-7 & 10-5-2: AS WRITTEN, ONLY APPLY TO FOULS OCCURRING AFTER A CHANGE OF TEAM POSSESSION.

o If the situations in 10-4-7 and 10-5-2 occur before a change of team possession, the penalty is enforced from the previous spot.

Momentum: WHEN THERE IS A SPOT OF MOMENTUM UNDER 8-5-2-a EXC.

 The basic spot is the spot of momentum. If the offense fouls behind this spot, penalize from the spot of the foul.

Spot fouls in 10-4-4: LIMITED TO FOULS BY THE OFFENSE

There are no defensive spot fouls.

<u>ENFORCING PENALTIES USING THE NEW LIMITATION AND ALL-BUT-ONE PRINICIPLE –</u> ALTERNATIVE PROCESS

THERE ARE VARIOUS WAYS TO UNDERSTAND AND IMPLEMENT THE RULE. THIS THREE-STEP PROCESS MAY ASSIST:

STEP 1:

DETERMINE THE ENFORCEMENT SPOT UNDER SECTION 5 AND THE ALL-BUT-ONE PRINCIPLE.

- If it is BEYOND the Neutral Zone, penalize as last year (3-and-1).
- If it is BEHIND the Neutral Zone, move to Step 2.

STEP 2:

ASK THE FOLLOWING ABOUT THE FOUL:

- Did the foul occur during a scrimmage down?
- Is the foul a live-ball foul treated as a live-ball foul?
- Did the foul occur prior to a change of possession?

If the answer to ANY question is NO, enforce the penalty as you did last year. If the answers to ALL questions are YES, enforce under the new rule as in Step 3.
