IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19

- Due to COVID-19 guidelines, only **2800** spectators will be allowed into the North Fresch Softball Complex per session. Tickets (\$13.00 each plus \$1.65 convenience fee) will be sold online exclusively at GoFan. Please be prepared to social distance while waiting to enter the park. Upon entry, everyone will get a temperature check and masks are mandatory at all times.
- Each ticket (\$13.00 each plus \$1.65 convenience fee) purchased is good for that session/ game only. The park will be cleared after each session for sanitization and there will be **no re-entry** to the park once you exit.
- There will not be a LHSAA/LHSCA coaches' gate due to the limited capacity. Non-participating coaches, administration, and officials will need to purchase a ticket to enter. Participating coaches **will not** be allowed to use their card for anyone other than themselves. Only submitted rostered coaches will be allowed entry with their team. The 24-team member roster will be strictly enforced and adhered to. Any person over and/or not listed on the 24 maximum roster limits will need a ticket due to the limited capacity, this includes trainers. **NO HOSPITALITY ROOM WILL BE PROVIDED DUE TO COVID-19.**
- Concession stands will be open, no outside food or beverage allowed.
- Media will be required to get a temperature check upon entry.
- Teams will be required to bring individual water bottles that do not conflict with LHSAA Partner Powerade. Coolers will not be provided due to COVID-19.
- Any Bi-District, Regional, Quarterfinal, Semi-Final or Final game that is cancelled due to COVID-19 will be a forfeit without a financial penalty to the school. Playoff games will not be postponed due to positive cases.

Team Entry	Each team must enter through the Entrance Gate listed on page 9 of this bulletin and will be checked in using each teams submitted roster form. <u>ALL SOFTBALL BATS SHALL BE COMPRESSION TESTED PRIOR TO/AND DURING TEAM PHOTOS. NO EXCEPTIONS.</u>
Team & Individual Pictures	RomaPics will be in attendance two (2) hours prior to the first games on Thursday and Friday. Participating team & individual pictures will <u>only</u> be taken during the assigned times & fields and before warming up for their game. Late arrivals will wait until RomaPics has an opening.
Practice Fields	Contact SPAR (337-527-2500) for availability and day and time to schedule. Contact must be made by 5:00 pm, Wednesday, April 29, 2020.
Game Fields	Fields 13-20: Infield is turf including the pitcher's mound and home plate. Outfield is natural grass. <i>Metal cleats are not allowed on the turf field pitching mounds and pitchers should make accommodations accordingly.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Turf shoes and molded cleats are allowed. ▪ <u>NO seeds, gum, tobacco, confetti and/or shelled products allowed. (SEE PROHIBITED ITEMS)</u>
Team Dugouts <i>(LHSAA By-law 6.13.9(4-5))</i>	The home team (higher seed) shall occupy the third base dugout, and the visiting team shall occupy the first base dugout.
Infield Warmup	Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield prior to the game. The home team shall take the infield first, followed by the visiting team.
Warm & Walk-Up Music	Walk up music is not permitted at the state tournament.
Team Post-Game Protocol <i>(LHSAA By-laws 5.11.11 & 5.11.14)</i>	<u>Finals:</u> Both schools are required to remain on the field, participate in the awards ceremony until its completion and cooperate and attend. Failure to do so will result in the offending school being fined.
Team Meals	Must be in uniform and present ticket. <i>(Thursday & Friday - Semifinal Rounds Only)</i>

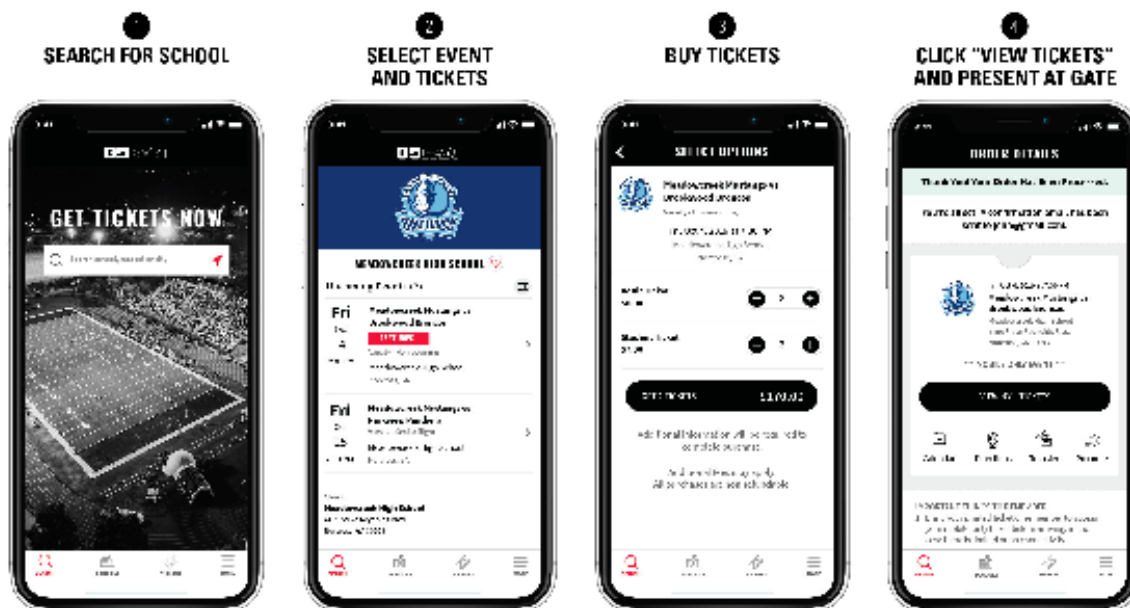

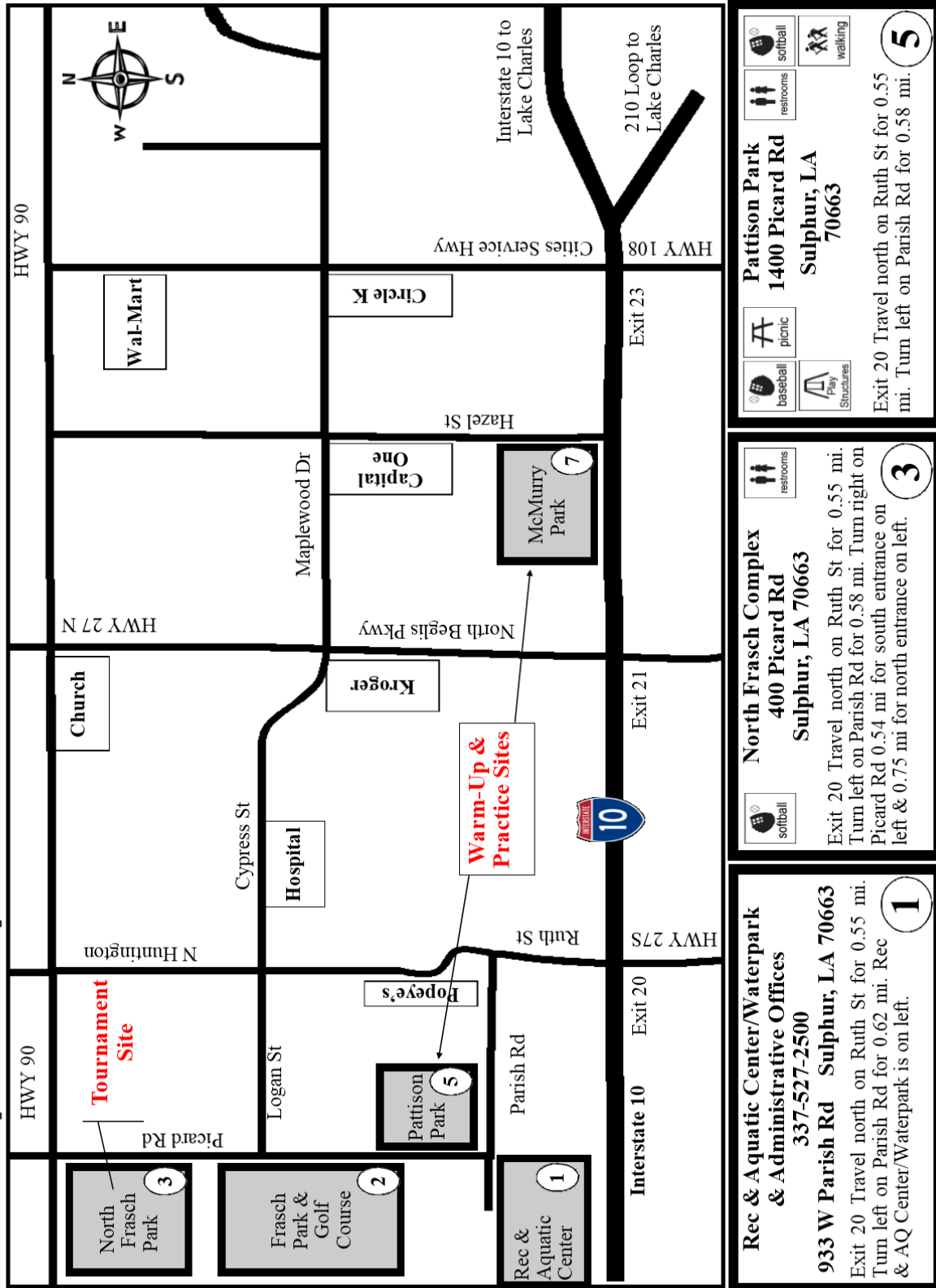

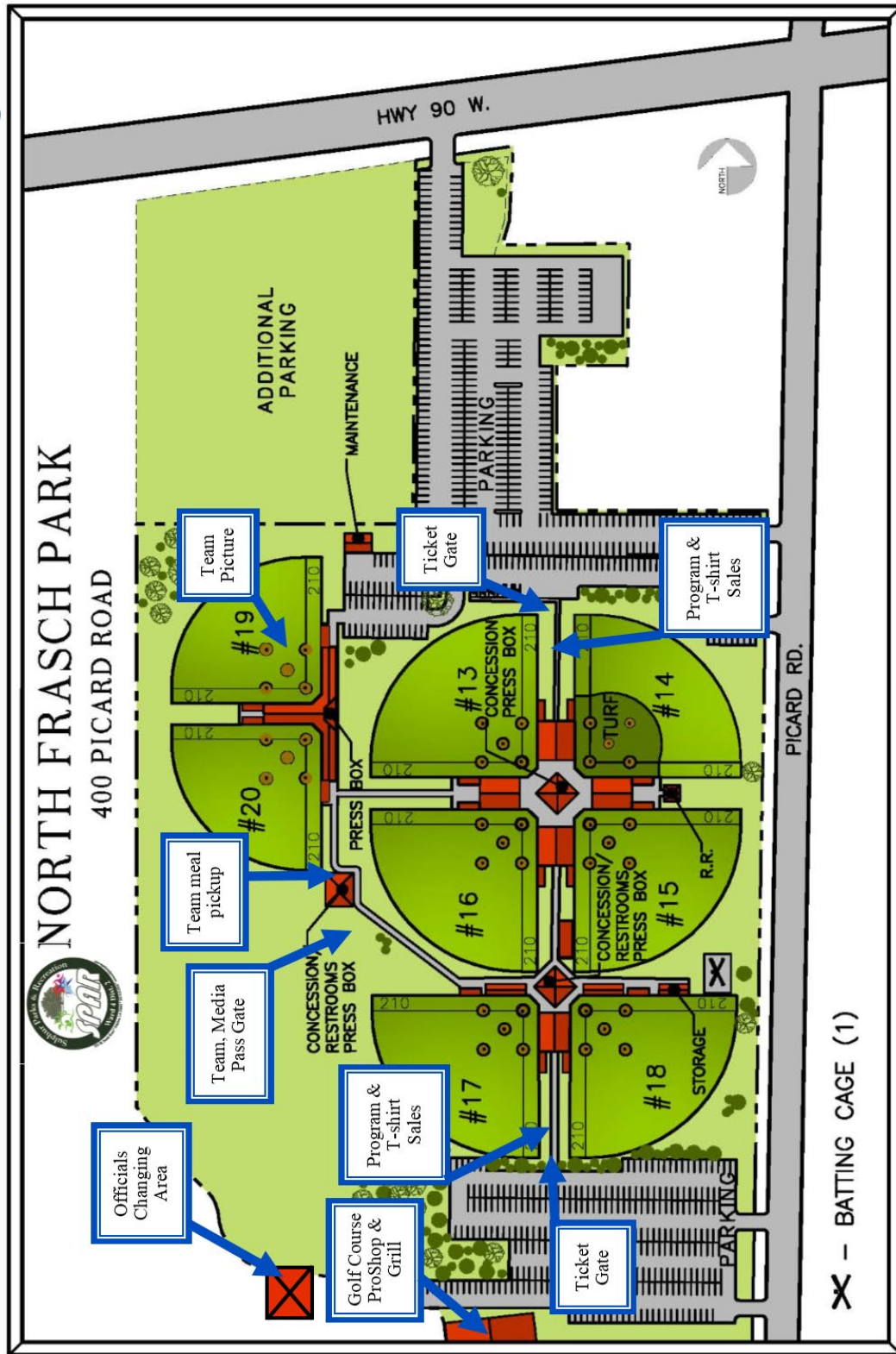
