PARKING AND FIELDS

From I-10, take the Lafayette, N. Evangeline Thruway Exit South and stay on US-90 (LA-182) into Broussard, LA. Take left on St. Nazaire Rd. and continue into St Julien Park. Continue East through the first traffic circle inside the park to the Blue Field Pod. Follow the South portion of the circle into the General Parking Lot.

General Parking is available where indicated in RED. **NO TAILGATING IS PERMITTED.** Spectator gates will open at 11:45 a.m. on Friday, April 29 and at 10:45 a.m. on Saturday, April 30.

Officials designated parking is indicated in GREEN.

Fields are identified in BLUE. BLUE 1 and BLUE 2 are reserved for pictures and bat testing.

Access gate are indicated in YELLOW. Only team busses will be permitted through the access gates



BUS PARKING AND TEAM ENTRANCES

From I-10, take the Lafayette, N. Evangeline Thruway Exit South and stay on US-90 (LA-182) into Broussard, LA. Take left on St. Nazaire Rd. and continue into St Julien Park. Continue East through the first traffic circle inside the park to the Blue Field Pod.

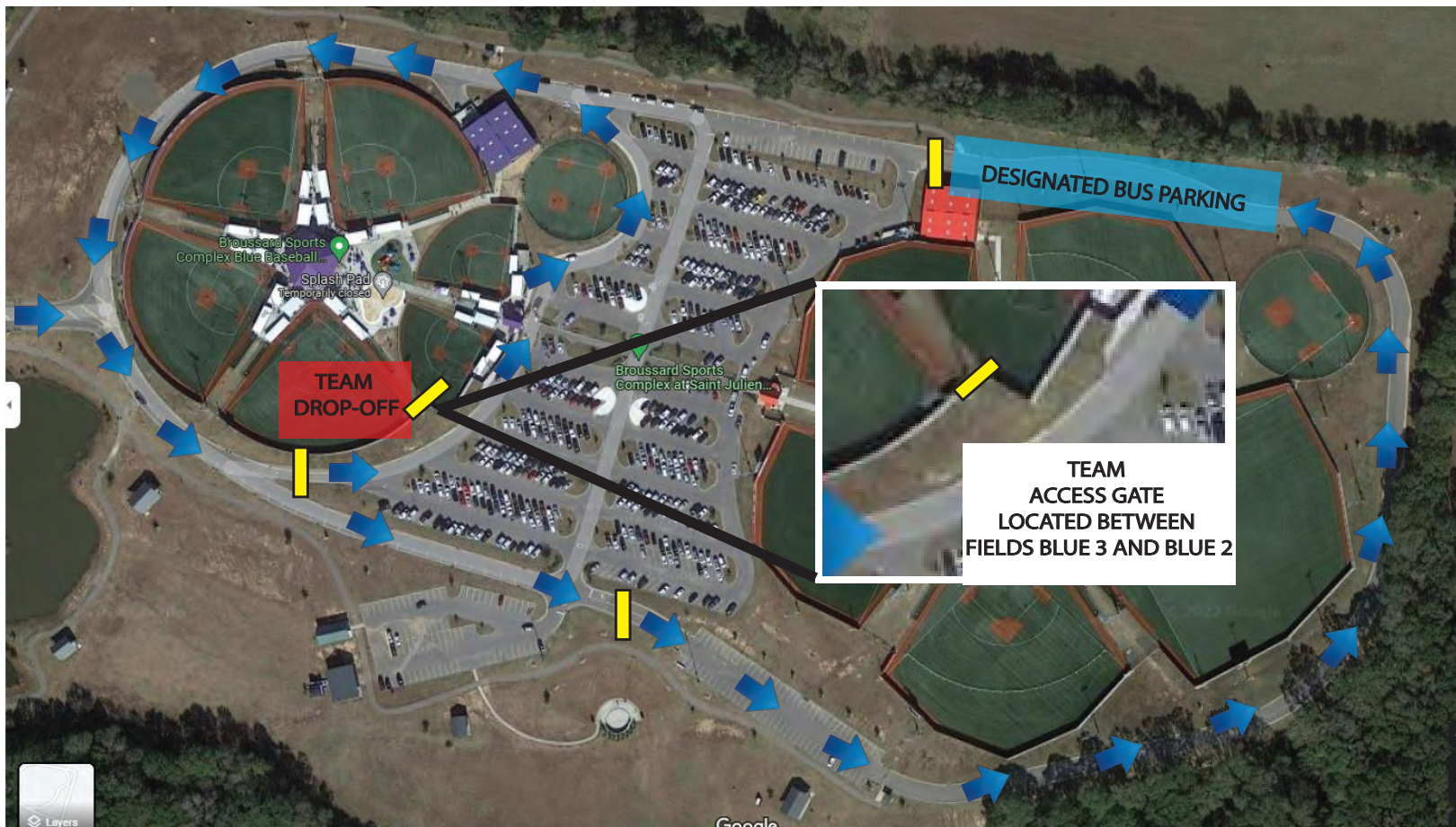

ACCESS GATE



BUS ROUTE. FROM ENTRANCE, TAKE A LEFT THROUGH ACCESS GATE IN FRONT OF BLUE POD AND DROP TEAM OFF AT TEAM ACCESS GATE BETWEEN FIELDS BLUE 3 AND BLUE 2. CIRCLE ALL THE WAY AROUND BLUE POD AND THEN CONTINUE ON SOUTH ACCESS ROAD AROUND RED POD. DESIGNATED BUS PARKING IS LOCATED ON ACCESS ROAD ABOVE RED POD.



TICKETING and REVENUE

All tickets for the LHSAA Girls' Select Softball Championships will be digital and available at www.slocaltix.com. Tickets will be sold on an individual game basis. Tickets can also be purchased at the gate via Credit Card. **NO CASH SALES OF TICKETS.**

Tickets will go on sale on Monday, April 25th at 6:00 p.m.

All game tickets are \$13.00 online (exclusive of fees) or \$16.00 at the gate.

Expenses associated with the LHSAA Girls' Select Softball Championships will be paid in full on a pro-rata reduction of the revenue of each game. After all expenses are paid, teams will divide the remaining revenue equally.



HOSPITALITY

Each participating team will receive three (3) meal tickets and (3) snack tickets for Friday and Saturday for coaches' meals that are redeemable at the Bon Temps Concession and Grill.

LHSCA COACHES CARDS

LHSCA Coaches' Cards will be accepted that the 2022 LHSAA Girls' Select State Softball Championships. There will be a dedicated check-in area for Coaches' Cards and Academic All-State Members. Coaches must present their Coaches' Card and a valid ID to receive their tickets. They will also register with the log of names.

PRACTICE AVAILABILITY and WARM UP

The Broussard Sportsplex will be available for practice on Thursday, April 28th. Practice slots are 2:00-4:00 pm, 4:00-6:00 pm, and 6:00-8:00 pm.

Teams will also be able to use the Red Pod on Friday, April 29th, for warm-ups prior to games.

Teams interested in practicing at the complex on Thursday must contact Dwayne Derise, dderise@broussardla.com or (337) 330-2337, to schedule the time.

Each team will have a ten minute period to take in-field prior to games. The home team will take in-field first followed by the visiting team.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Disorderly conduct and physical/verbal assault will not be tolerated.

Swimming in Ponds prohibited. Catch and Release fishing only.

Climbing on trees, goalposts, fences, structures, etc. prohibited

All outside food or drink prohibited in SJPSJC during events without Administrative permission.

Skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, bikes and all wheeled devices not allowed in SJP.

Obscene behavior or profane language will not be tolerated.

All athletic field use must have prior approval from Director of SJP.

Glass bottles or containers are prohibited in the park.

Gum or seeds in shells: sunflower, peanut or pistachio etc. not allowed in the park.

Only team/player coolers are allowed at the fields. No team ice chest allowed.

Pets are prohibited on the fields or in the Baseball or Softball Complex. Pets are only allowed on hard surface trails and must be leashed at all times.

Players, Coaches and Officials only on playing fields on game days.

Metal spikes are prohibited on all artificial turf and portable mounds. Tennis shoes, turf shoes, and rubber cleats are acceptable.

Food or beverages are prohibited on playing fields.

Cooking or food preparation is prohibited in the park without approval from concessionaire.

Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco are strictly prohibited. The law will be enforced.

Sale of merchandise or operate any concessions is prohibited without prior approval.

All postings and field markings must be pre-arranged and approved by St. Julien Park Administration and fees may apply.

Specific permission is required prior to posting any signs or decorations.

Loudspeakers are prohibited unless prior consent is given.

BROUSSARD SPORTS COMPLEX

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Music prohibited inside the facility unless permit is given by St. Julien Park.

Artificial noise makers are prohibited during all athletic activity.

Vehicles are prohibited on sod surfaces, sidewalks, service driveways and emergency zones. Any vehicle found in an unauthorized parking area will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense.

Overnight parking and camping is prohibited including RV's and campers.

Planes or drones not allowed without prior approval.

Park may be closed at any time due to safety related concerns.

Littering and dumping trash is strictly prohibited.

Loitering or soliciting is never allowed at SJPSC.

Firearms, primitive weapons, air guns, fires, fireworks, flammable liquids, open burning, or use of any device with an open flame is prohibited unless special permit given for special events.

Speed limit in the park is 15 mph and 5 mph in all parking areas.

Cars parked in handicapped parking spaces without a handicap sticker will be fined.

All tournament and league participants, spectators, coaches, players, vendors, walkers, runners, playground areas, splash pad and picnic areas are at risk to be hit with a baseball/softball/soccer ball. Be alert at all times.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate removal from park.

Team pictures will take place on the Blue 1 Field. Teams should report to Blue 1 upon entering the park.
