STATE MEET INFORMATION

SCRATCH / DROP OUT INFORMATION

SCRATCH DEADLINE: Tuesday, May 6, 2025 at 12 noon.

A scratch must be submitted on school letterhead, signed by the coach and school principal, and emailed to Adam MacDowell (amacdowell@lhsaa.org).

The school that scratches a contestant is responsible for notifying the alternate contestant's school. If a qualifying contestant from the regional meet is scratched and the alternate is not notified prior to the scratch deadline, there shall be no replacement allowed.

Bylaw 23.6.13: "There will be no scratch meeting for the state meet. Schools that qualify contestants from the regional meet to the state meet shall declare by noon on Tuesday of the week of the state meet any scratches for those qualifying to the state meet. It will be the responsibility of the school that scratches a contestant to notify the alternate school gualifier by noon on Tuesday of the week of the state meet. Schools failing to scratch contestants prior to noon on Tuesday of the state meet shall be fined \$50 per contestant unless a letter from a doctor or the principal stipulates that the contestant was unable to compete due to medical reasons or other unusual circumstances."

Each School is responsible for notifying alternate qualifiers and the LHSAA office if participant will not compete in State Meet - must be notified by 12:00 noon, Tuesday, May 6, 2025.


RELAY ALTERNATE CHANGES

State Relay Additions and Substitutions - Deadline Noon, Tuesday May 6th

- O Click on Meet Registration link (upper right)
- O Click on your team's name
- Make your changes to relays
- O Click Done button
- O Go back and verify all entries

Editing Relay Instructions:

When editing your relay entries, If you are attempting to register more athletes to your relay team than you had previously registered for the regional meet (Ex. You registered 7 athletes for the regional meet but now want to list 8 athletes for state), you must adjust the "Athletes on Relay" field. To do so, click on the "Athletes on Relay" drop down listed just above your relay's seed time and select the correct number of athletes that will be listed:



Once done, you will now be permitted to add additional athletes by checking the box next to their name on the right hand side. Click save once your relay team is set.

** If your entry edits will not increase the total number of athletes on the relay team, no action is required. For example, if you are simply removing one athlete and adding another, you will not be required to edit the "Athletes on Relay" field.

HEAT SHEET INFORMATION

DISPUTE PERIOD: <u>Tuesday, May 6, 2025 12 p.m. noon to 4 p.m.</u>

Bylaw 23.6.5: "Prior to the state meet, the LHSAA shall place a state meet memorandum on its website and notify all schools when available. Each head track coach shall be notified by email as to when the heat sheets are available. Once notified the participating schools shall have four hours to review, appeal, or dispute the school's heat sheets which are posted on the LHSAA website. The only changes that will be considered at this time shall be errors in reporting/posting by the Regional Meet Director or the LHSAA administration. Omissions/errors by the participating schools are not appealable or disputable."

PACKET PICKUP

9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. in the Carl Maddox Indoor Track Field House.

Team Packets contain Heat Sheets, Participant wristbands (alternates included), appeal form and pole vault coaches pass and weigh-in information if applicable.

ONLY the Head Coach shall pick up team packets and will be required to sign the equipment verification form. Assistant Coaches or Faculty Representatives must present a valid ID and a letter from the principal in order to pick up team packets. If a school enters no more than two contestants in the meet, the student(s) may be accompanied by a faculty coach/representative or an LHSAA approved Non-Faculty coach from any other school/system entered in the meet, if both schools' principals give written permission. The written permission shall be presented to the meet director at the packet pickup area.

Pick-up AFTER 2:00pm – packets will be available in the southwest corner (near section 14) of the press box in the Track and Field Stadium.

PARTICIPATION PASSES

Received in packet at Packet Pick-up. One wristband is given to each student-athlete qualifying for the Meet (including alternates listed on the entry sheet). Participants must have a wristband with them at all times and present a pass at the pass gate to be admitted free of charge. Pass is only applicable for their competition day only. Contestants must remain in stands or check-in area.

POLE VAULTERS WEIGHT CERTIFICATION - GATE 14

<u>GATE 14</u>

Pole vaulter's weight verification forms, (located in team packet), must be presented to the meet official at weighin. This form must be filled in completely and signed by all parties as listed. Failure to bring this form will disqualify your contestant in the pole vault event. <u>Coaches with pole vaulters must have athlete(s) in the</u> <u>Equipment Room at least 1-1/2 hours prior to their event for verification of weight and pole rating</u>. All pole vaulters will be weighed at this time and poles will be marked for competition at this time.

All coaches that have vaulters competing will be allowed on the infield and restricted to the coaching area near the vault during their event.

Pole Vault Coaches must have the dedicated wristband to enter the infield. The Pole Vault wristband will be distributed at Packet Pickup to registered coaches ONLY.

Only coaches registered with their school as an outdoor track and field coach and wearing the pole vault coach's bracelet shall be permitted on the infield in the coaches box. Any coach in the designated coaches box that is not registered with the member school of student(s) in which they are coaching will be penalized under 5.11.22 in the LHSAA Handbook.

<u>Rule 3-2 Article 8 of the NFHS Track & Field Handbook states</u>: Electronic devices may be used in unrestricted areas and coaching boxes, provided the location does not interfere with the progress of the meet as determined by the meet referee.


1. Electronic devices shall not be used to transmit information to the competitor during the race or trial.

2. Electronic devices shall not be used for any review of an official's decision.

EQUIPMENT CHECK - GATE 13

Uniform and Track Shoes: All competitors shall follow Rule 4-2 Section 3 of the NFHS Track & Field Rules Book for Uniform and Track Shoe Compliance.

Track Shoes/Spikes: All spikes must be checked outside at <u>Gate 13 of Bernie Moore Track</u>. Spikes must be checked prior to accessing the Bernie Moore Track or entering the Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. Athletes will not be able to compete without having their spikes tagged. Any athletes competing with non-tagged spikes will be disqualified. Acceptable spikes: ¼" pyramids.



Batons and Blocks: LSU will supply all batons and starting blocks. **Tape:** Tape located at each exchange zone provided by LSU.

EVENT CALLS

30 minutes prior to event

Two calls for each event. The first call is 30 minutes prior to the event and the last call is 20 minutes prior to the start of the event. Calls are made at the check-in area only.

Contestants must report immediately to the check-in area on the first call and no later than 20 minutes prior to their event. After reporting and being checked, they may continue to warm-up/participate in other events prior to the next event.

PRACTICE / WARM-UP

9:30AM - 10:45AM GATE 12 / BERNIE MOORE TRACK STADIUM

Team packets shall first be picked up by the head coach and all participating athletes must wear their competitor wristbands to be eligible to enter the track. Any tape or marks placed on the track or field event runways during practice will be removed prior to the competition.

<u>The indoor track will be available at **10:45 a.m**</u>. for warmups. No team camps and no athlete bathrooms will be available in the indoor track. No dressing rooms are available. All contestants will warm up and report for events in the grassy area next to the field house.

NOTE: PARTICIPANTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE EVENTS IF A COACH, MANAGER, OR A TEAM ATTENDANT IS DISCOVERED ON THE TRACK OR IN THE FIELD EVENT AREA WHILE COMPETITION FOR HIS/HER EVENT IS IN PROGRESS. (Exception – Designated pole vault coaches within the coaches' box)

FIELD EVENTS

START TIME: 12:00PM at GATE 11

Contestants are only allowed inside the track when competing. <u>All throwing implements will be weighed and</u> <u>measured near Gate 14</u>, inside the track. All implement weigh-ins will open 90 minutes prior to the first field event and will remain open throughout the competition. Implements shall be weighed at least 90 minutes prior to each event. TOP 7 go to Finals (one more than scoring). Pole Vault & High Jump are seeded randomly by height.

RUNNING EVENTS

Athlete Check-In: GATE 12 (See diagram on page 12)

START TIME: 2:30PM

Contestants are only allowed inside the track when competing.

- <u>4x100 Meter Relay:</u>
- 30-meter exchange zone
- Start line white
- Between the white lines before the numbers on the track and the second mark in gold.

4x200 Meter Relay:

- 30-meter exchange zone
- Start red with a white line
- Exchanges from 1 to 2 and 2 to 3 Between the red line. Exchange from 3 to 4 - Between the gold line. (No acceleration zone, just one big zone.)


4x400 Meter Relay (3-turn stagger)

- Start white with a blue line
- 20-meter exchange zone between blue marks

NOTE: LSU's track is updated to reflect 30-meter exchange zones for the 4x100m. Tape provided by LSU.

800 Meter Run: Use one-turn stagger - runner may move to inside beyond flag/ cones on back straightaway if he/she has more than one stride advantage on contestants on inside.

1600 and 3200 Meter Run: Use waterfall start - runner may move to inside if he/she has more than one stride advantage over contestants on his/her inside.



MULTI- EVENT CONFLICT

Competitors will be allowed to jump/throw out of order, in the preliminaries but delaying the competition during the prelims will not be allowed. Competitors will be allowed to jump/throw out of their assigned order in the finals, but they will only be allowed to move up in the order of jumps/throws. Students must take <u>ALL</u> jumps prior to leaving. There will be a 10-minute time limit for competitors that are excused by the field event judge to compete in another event. No protest will be accepted if the competition concludes within this 10-minute time period as athletes are encouraged to take their throws/jumps prior to being excused.

WHEELCHAIR AND PARA-AMBULATORY INFORMATION

THURSDAY, MAY 8TH; START TIME APPROX. 6:00PM

Wheelchair Track and Field:

Any questions concerning wheelchair track and field should be answered by applying to the section of the LHSAA handbook dealing with participation in wheelchair track and field. This information can be found in the LHSAA Handbook: Section 23.

Note: All Wheelchair athletes will compete on Thursday, May 8th (First day of the meet).

FRIDAY, MAY 9TH: START TIME APPROX. 5:40PM

Para-Ambulatory:

A para-ambulatory athlete shall have a permanent orthopedic, neuromuscular, or other physical disability. Permanent orthopedic impairment shall be verified by a licensed physician and maintained on permanent file at the school.

Note: All para-ambulatory athletes will compete on <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 9th</u> (Second day of the meet).

AWARDS

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in all individual and relay events will be announced and awarded at the podium immediately following each event. Athletes shall not wait for award presentations if they have been released from a field event or have a running event in which they need to report.

MVP awards are presented during the team trophy presentation at the conclusion of the meet for each classification. Selected by the working media based on best performance and/or total points.

ALL- ACADEMIC

There will be no All - Academic Award presentation at the State Meet. Principals and Administrators may print the All- Academic Awards from the LHSAA member site to be presented at each school's Awards Banquet and/or Athletic/Academic Convocation.

MEDIA

Location: CARL MADDOX INDOOR FIELD HOUSE

COACHES AND ADMINISTRATOR ENTRANCE

<u>GATE 2</u>: Must present LHSAA/LHSCA card and a valid driver's license to accompany the card. Passes are not transferable. Guest must arrive with you if applicable. **<u>Coaches gate will open at 9:00AM.</u>**

TICKETS - ONLINE ONLY

Ticket window will open at 10:00AM. Tickets are only available online and can be purchased for \$18.00, through the day of the event. Children ages 2 and under are free. SPECTATOR/ GUEST ENTRANCE & SPECTATOR STUDENT -ATHLETES AND COACHES

GATE 3: Gates will open at 11:00am

<u>Radio/Cell Phones</u>: No radios or portable stereos/speakers will be allowed in Bernie Moore Track Stadium. Please remind your athletes of this policy. No cell phones or walkie-talkies will be allowed on the track or infield at any time during the meet by participating athletes.

<u>Ice Chests/Coolers</u>: No coolers, ice chests, or storage containers are allowed. These should be left on the school bus or a team-monitored tent area on the grass practice field.

Tents/Tarps/Umbrellas: No tents are allowed inside the stadium. Tents are only allowed in grassy areas outside the stadium. Umbrellas block the view of spectators and shall not be used inside the stadium.

Food and Drinks: Water is only permitted drink allowed on the rubber surface at Bernie Moore Stadium and inside Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. Team food is only permitted in the bleachers at Bernie Moore Stadium.

<u>Bags</u>: Only shoe bags and drawstring bags are permitted inside Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. No bags of excessive size (backpacks, duffel bags, suitcases, coolers) are permitted inside the Fieldhouse.

PARKING INFORMATION/ BUS PARKING INFORMATION

Please plan to arrive early for events and to find alternate directions to and from the campus. Please use www.LSUSports.net/WAZE and/or download the Waze app.

LSU recommends all schools review directions in advance and map out their routes and drop-off locations. In addition, all teams should communicate internally to coordinate locations for staff and athletes to rendezvous.

BUS DROP OFF: LOT 407 (gravel lot near River Road)

Busses will not be allowed to drop off/unload along Nicholson Dr. In addition, several left turns will not accessible in the southbound lane of Nicholson. Please see the attached map for recommendations for bus drop-off and parking locations. Bus parking will be located in lot 407 - gravel lot near River Road, west of Tiger Park and across from the Vet School. Busses will NOT be allowed to park in Lot 104-Bernie Moore, Lot 105-Carl Maddox, or Lot 106-Carl Maddox Grass.

Bus Drop-off Directions (From Nicholson, southbound traffic)

Heading southbound on Nicholson; Turn Left at Aster Street; Turn right at Iowa Street (unload in front of the LSU Natatorium); Turn Left on W. Chimes St.; Turn Left on Alaska St.; Turn Left on W. Roosevelt St.; Turn Left on Nicholson; Proceed southbound to Skip Bertman Drive; Turn Right on Skip Bertman Dr.; Proceed top Lot 407.




Bus Pick-up Directions (From Lot 407 to the interstate)
