- Any combination of the above experience may be considered with approval from the Executive Director and the LHSCA Executive Council.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Active involvement and background in high school athletics.
- Past service on LHSCA committees.
- Strong organizational, communication, and technological skills.
- Knowledge of the challenges and opportunities facing high school athletics at both the state and national levels.
- High ethical standards, integrity, and leadership ability.

- Supervise All-Star games, coach clinics, and special recognition programs.
- Develop business plans and pursue fundraising and grant opportunities.
- Maintain and enhance the LHSCA website and social media presence.
- Plan and coordinate meetings for the LHSCA Executive Council.
- Support Recognized Coaches Associations across the state.
- Represent the LHSCA in public relations and communication efforts.

The Director will report directly to the LHSAA Executive Director and will be subject to an annual performance review with input from the LHSCA Executive Council.
