CHANGE IN SCHEDULE NOTICE: LHSAA BOYS' AND GIRLS' STATE GOLF

LAFAYETTE - Because of the possibility of inclement weather in the Acadiana area Tuesday and Wednesday, the schedule for the 2025 LHSAA Boys' and Girls' State Golf Championships has been altered.

Monday's scheduled play is unchanged and will be held at the previously announced times. Pairings and tee times are listed here on the LHSAA web site.

Tuesday's play in all six divisions and at all four courses will be in a shotgun format in an attempt to play at least 27 holes to determine the championships. If possible, a second nine holes will be played on Tuesday, also in a shotgun format, to finish the 36-hole championship.

The revised schedule for TUESDAY:

Boys Division I -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the front 9 at The Wetlands

Boys Division II -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the front 9 at The Farm d'Allie

Boys Division III -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the back 9 at The Wetlands

Boys Division IV -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the front 9 at Cane Row

Girls Division I -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the front 9 at Les Vieux Chenes

Girls Division II -- 8 a.m. shotgun on the back 9 at Les Vleux Chenes

Players on front nines will go from No. 9 to No. 1, and on back nines will go from No. 18 to No. 10, until nine holes are completed. If divisions finish nine holes and weather is not imminent, after a short break, play will continue on the opposite nine holes in an effort to get in a full 18-hole round and a 36-hole championship.

Pairings for the shotgun start will be posted on the LHSAA web site as soon as possible after the conclusion of Monday's play.

COACHES -- A MANDATORY meeting will be held at 7:15 A.M. TUESDAY at each course, where instructions and scorecards will be distributed, and plans will be finalized to take players onto the course for the shotgun start.
