The number of multi-sport officials has increased 10-percent — a milestone that showcases the momentum behind our push to expand this vital group across Louisiana.

Each multi-sport official will receive a commemorative flipping coin as a token of appreciation. This year's design celebrates Louisiana's unique cultural heritage, featuring a magnolia on the black side and a alligator on the blue side. The LHSAA logo is featured on the blue side, while the LHSOA logo is displayed on the reverse. The coin not only serves as a keepsake but also as a symbol of the officials' important role in supporting the integrity of high school athletics.

Beyond honoring current officials, the LHSAA and LHSOA are actively working to recruit and train the next generation of multi-sport officials. With the growing demands of high school athletics, the need for trained, qualified individuals is greater than ever. By encouraging more officials to work additional sports, the associations aim to ensure that student-athletes statewide continue to benefit from interscholastic competition.
