## LHSAA LAUNCHES THE LOUISIANA PROJECT, A COMPREHENSIVE RESEARCH INITIATIVE TO SAFEGUARD STUDENT-ATHLETES ACROSS THE STATE

**Baton Rouge, LA** — The Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) and EverRise (<a href="www.everrise.ai">www.everrise.ai</a>), a national research and leadership development company, have announced the launch of The Louisiana Project, a groundbreaking initiative designed to gather critical data and insights to quantify the impact coaching has on the academic, social and emotional growth of high school student-athletes across the state.

The project builds on the findings of EverRise's landmark report, *The State of Coaching: Understanding the Impact and Future*, which analyzed data from over 45,000 student-athletes across 24 states — including Louisiana. That study revealed compelling insights into how coaching quality directly affects student performance. For example, athletes coached by leaders strong in connection and communication saw GPA increases of 0.61 points on a 4.0 scale. Those coached by connected and structured leaders attended 12 more days of school than their peers — equating to over two weeks of additional instruction.

The Louisiana Project focuses specifically on Louisiana's coaching landscape and student-athlete experience with a goal of empowering schools, coaches, and policymakers with actionable insights to improve outcomes statewide.

"This study is essential to provide the data needed to protect student-athletes and understand the full impact of high school sports," LHSAA Executive Director Eddie Bonine said. "By including schools across the state, we can ensure every student's experience is represented and that Louisiana leads the way in evidence-based support for its student-athletes."

"The changing landscape in high school and college athletics demands validated research and data for every state and locality, as they all are dealing with a multitude of challenges and needs," EverRise President and Chief Strategy Officer Chuck Schmidt said. "We anticipate this is the first of many such studies."

EverRise will conduct assessments with thousands of student-athletes across multiple sports and school types — urban, rural, large, small, public, and private — to build a robust and representative dataset. These assessments will measure academic performance, attendance, engagement, and personal development, with the goal of quantifying the impact of coaches and athletic programs on student-athletes' growth.
