The three-day event will feature quarterfinal, semifinal, and championship matches across all five divisions.

On Championship Saturday, play transitions to a single featured court on the Cajundome floor. The finals will begin with Division V at 9:00 a.m. and conclude with Division I, scheduled to start at 7:00 p.m.
