

LHSAA Set for 2025 State Swim Meet at Sulphur Parks & Recreation Aquatic Center

SULPHUR, La. – The Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) will return to the Sulphur Parks & Recreation (SPAR) Aquatic Center from November 19–22 for the 2025 LHSAA State Swim Meet. Across four days and all four divisions, the state’s fastest high school swimmers will compete for championship titles in an event that annually brings together student-athletes and fans from throughout Louisiana.

“This meet has become one of the most exciting championship environments we offer,” said Michael Federico, LHSAA Assistant Executive Director and State Swim Meet Director. “The atmosphere inside the SPAR Aquatic Center is incredible, the energy, the noise, the support from teams of all sizes. It’s a championship that truly brings the entire swimming community together.”

Fans are strongly encouraged to plan ahead. Tickets are available exclusively online through the LHSAA’s official ticketing partner, GoFan, with links available on the swim page of the LHSAA website. There will be *no re-entry* for fans, so attendees should prepare accordingly before entering the facility.

The spectator entrance has moved from previous years and will now be through the Water Park entrance at SPAR. Fans should also visit sulphurparks.com to familiarize themselves with facility rules, policies, and parking information prior to arrival.
